Attendance and Absence on EMS placements 2024-25

Full attendance and participation on EMS placements is compulsory and essential for you to pass each EMS placement.

If you are absent from an EMS placement for any reason you must inform the EMS placements office EMS@rvc.ac.uk as soon as possible. As part of your performance record, all absences are recorded and monitored.

Students are permitted up to 1 day of absence for a 1-week EMS placement, and up to 2 days of absence for a 2-week EMS placement for approved reasons such medical reasons or extenuating circumstances as directed by the table below. Where a student has been absent for more than this, they will be required to make up the days at a future EMS placement or repeat the placement at the next scheduled opportunity.

^{*}Where a student has been absent for more than this, they will be required to make up the days or repeat the EMS placement at the next scheduled opportunity.

Please note: Where there has been an absence, it is still your responsibility to ensure that you demonstrate a pass performance in the time you are on the EMS placement and that you have completed any compulsory elements within the EMS placement. This may mean that you need to return to the EMS placement to cover the mandatory requirements missed.

Lateness

A student arriving late should observe professional courtesy and explain circumstances to the EMS placement host. A single episode of lateness may result in student receiving a verbal reminder from the EMS Directors or tutor of the importance of punctuality. Repeated lateness could lead to a cause for concern note issued by the EMS Directors or potentially failing of the EMS placement.

Patterns of Absence

Attendance and absences are monitored throughout the IMR & EMS cycle and this is particularly important for students with visas that require attendance monitoring. Where there are multiple absences or patterns of absence across multiple EMS placements, the senior tutors and a student's individual academic tutor will be informed, and the student may be expected to attend a meeting for further discussion and support.

Further Advice
